

Big Firms Get Bigger

SDM's seventh annual ranking of the largest electronic security firms shows that the biggest of the big are disproportionately outpacing the rest of the industry.



As in years past, the largest 100 security firms continued in 1996 to capture a fourth of total industry revenue.

hen industrywide growth clocks in at just 2.2% — as it did in 1996, when total security industry revenues went from \$12.9 billion to \$13.2 billion — and the industry's largest firms experience a 21.5% growth rate in the same year, something's askew.

In fact, the variance exists even within the 1997 SDM 100, a table that ranks the largest electronic-security firms by 1996 gross revenue. It was the top 25 companies that had this phenomenal growth rate, while the bottom 25 on the SDM 100, by contrast, had only 2.4% average annual growth in 1996, with many firms experiencing negative growth.

The reason: Through a combined effort of increasing installation activity (often through "dealer" programs) plus purchasing installed subscriber accounts (at least 16 of the top 25 firms did acquisitions in 1996), these "giants" are realizing the recurring revenue potential of critical mass. For example, recurring annual revenue for the No. 1 firm, ADT Security Services, went from \$527 million in 1995 to \$708 million in 1996, a 34% increase. ADT now has

nearly 1.5 million subscribers, and several others in the top 10 are approaching the half-million mark.

In the middle and lower part of the list, the picture isn't as rosy, although a select few companies experienced good growth in 1996 due to either a strong local economy or a strong marketing program. In 1995 and 1996, several of the smaller, more traditional entrepreneurial firms began residential low- or no-cost installation programs. The results of these programs will be evident in a few years. The firms in the middle and lower part of the list also were active purchasers in 1996, but typically netted much fewer accounts overall than the larger firms.

In 1996, at least 43 alarm dealers actively pursued the acquisition market — acquiring 182 companies and gaining more than 180,000 subscriber accounts. (This is a very conservative estimate because not every firm in the SDM 100 reported its acquisition activity.)

Who Qualifies for the SDM 100?

To qualify for listing on the SDM 100, a firm must be an installer — that is, operate an installation department/division or contract

How to Read the Listings

The SDM 100 ranks, by 1996 gross revenue, firms that provide electronic security systems and services to both residential and nonresidential markets. This ranking is based on information provided to SDM by each firm.

Reading across, the first piece of information is the firm's 1997 rank, based on 1996 gross revenues (figures may be rounded). If the firm was previously ranked, then the 1996 rank appears to the right.

Next, the company name and location appear. The third column shows

total U.S. revenue in calendar- or fiscal-year 1996 from security system sales/installation, service, leasing, and monitoring. A *v* after the number means that this firm has submitted the appropriate documentation that verifies the stated revenue, either for 1996, 96, or the prior year, 95. A *vu* means that although documentation was submitted, it wasn't audited or reviewed by a third party. An *e* means the revenue is estimated by *SDM*.

The fourth column shows the percentage change from 1995 to 1996

gross revenue, where applicable.

The fifth column contains the number of subscribers, or customers, each firm counts, while the sixth shows the number of new systems that the firm installed in 1996. In this column, an *R* following a figure represents residential systems and a *C* represents commercial.

The seventh column shows the number of full-time employees and the last column indicates the total number of locations, including both headquarters and branch offices.

Total gross revenue in 1996 from SDM 100 firms reached \$3.29 billion, a 10% increase over the prior year. However, because the listed firms aren't required to release financial information, some do not provide their recurring revenue, number of accounts, or installation volume. Therefore, exercise care in using this information to extrapolate industry totals.

The Fallout

Consolidation in the industry infiltrated all levels. Firms that were acquired included some in the top 10 of the SDM 100. Among those missing from the 1997 SDM 100 due to acquisition:

Westinghouse Security Systems, acquired by Westar Security, No.6;

ASH (Automated Security Holdings) USA, acquired by ADT;

Sentry Alarm Systems of America and National Security Service, both acquired by Entergy Security Inc., No. 16;

Metrol/Dictograph Security Services, acquired by Protection One, No. 8; and

Commonwealth Security Systems, acquired by Republic Security Services, No. 7.

In all, there are 20 firms listed for the first time on the 1997 SDM 100, most ranked in the lower 50.

for installation services — and must sell and install electronic security systems, such as intrusion (burglar) alarms, fire alarms, access control, and/or CCTV systems, as well as other types of systems. These firms may also provide field service and monitoring; however, firms that provide only service and monitoring do not qualify.

There are three ways to compare and contrast the SDM 100 companies: by gross revenue, as listed in the main tables on the following pages; by annual recurring revenue, as shown in the table on page 94; and by installation volume, in the table on page 92.





In terms of sales dollars earned by SDM 100 firms, almost two-thirds stemmed from the sale of burglar alarm systems.








Many SDM 100 firms experienced substantial growth in their installation departments in 1996, as reflected by the 26% increase in total residential installations between 1995 and 1996.
